The Fort Whipple Museum, a joint project of the Sharlot Hall Museum and the Bob Stump Veterans Affairs Medical Center, is located on the grounds of the VA Hospital in Prescott. Housed in one of the 1905 military officer's quarters, the Museum traces the history of Fort Whipple with exhibits that include medical instruments, Army weaponry, America's Buffalo Soldiers, maps and photographs. The museum staff presents quarterly living history programs highlighting Arizona's military history that are both entertaining and educational.
